| 2/a | Market Area, Stall erecting | Slips, trips & falls, crush injuries, strains & cuts Stall erecting team tripping or slipping on or over stall framework when laying on the ground. | Public and Stall Holder staff | First aid kit available. Ensure any unauthorised personnel are not allowed in area. Minimise distance equipment is carried. Work team reminded of need for care and communication in manual handling. Stall layout plan established. All stall erecting staff must be competent. Extra care in adverse weather conditions | Low | Stephen Jones | Every market day |
| 2/b | Market Area, Stall erecting | Carrying boxes of fruit and vegetable in arms - Dropping items on foot - Carrying items from the car to the milk float - Colliding into objects or people - Improper lifting technique | Stall Holder staff | Restrict number of items carried at any one time •All staff trained in manual handling techniques | Low | Stephen Jones | Every market day |
| 3 | Market Area with stalls erected and market in progress | Slips, Trips and Falls | Public and Stall Holder | First aid kit available, hazard tape deployed if required, Safety check carried out prior to stallholders/customer s arriving and recorded. Stall holders to ensure that stall areas are kept clean and safe. Electrical cables to taped down to avoid trips | Low | Stephen Jones | Every market day |
